



Sabellid, Serpulid and Eunicid Identification

Dr Maria Cristina Gambi, Professor Adriana Giangrande, and Dr Margherita Licciano will be running a five day expert workshop on the identification of Sabellids, Serpulids and Eunicids at the Marine Biological Association in Plymouth.

Dr Gambi, Prof. Giangrande and Dr Licciano are leading researchers in the systematic, ecological and reproductive biology of polychaetes based at the Benthic Ecology Laboratory of the Zoological Station "Anton Dohrn" of Naples, the University of Lecce and the University of Salento with over 300 published scientific papers between them. Short lectures will be given introducing Sabellids, Serpulids and Eunicids and participants will be guided through the identification to species level by the course experts. The main focus of the week will be microscope work, allowing students to work through specimens at their own pace. Participants are encouraged to bring along their own specimens for advice on identification.



Course fee (5 days): £900, reduced to £720 for full-time students and volunteer taxonomists. This includes lunch, teas and coffees during breaks Monday - Friday and a course meal (with wine) on one evening during the week but not overnight accommodation or other main meals. Also included is one-year membership to the Marine Biological Association with on-line journal access. Existing (continuing) members of the MBA pay a reduced fee of £850, or £670 for students and voluntary taxonomists.
